Terms and Conditions

This contract includes very important information to individuals ("Participant") participating into a wine tour organized by International Gourmet d/b/a "Gourmet Travel" ("Gourmet Travel").

Payment of a deposit by the participant for a tour shall represent consent and acknowledgment of all provisions and conditions of this contract and of any brochure given to the participant.
All checks must be made payable to Gourmet Travel.

Participants are required to be 21 years of age at the beginning of the tour, in order to comply with Georgia law on alcoholic beverage consumption.

Package/Tour content:

Wine tours organized by Gourmet Travel include the following visits and features:

1. Domestic transportation from/back to Paris airport (or any convenient airport chosen by Gourmet Travel) from/to the region where the wine tour takes place. This transport will be organized by car, train, coach or plane, according to the region and availabilities. Gourmet Travel will not be able to pick up the participant at another airport than the one they specified to the participant.
2. Visits of wineries and diverse monuments, attractions or sightseeing
3. Luncheons or dinners at wineries or local restaurants
4. Lodgings
5. A booklet summarizing the key points of the tour
6. Two to three staff members to accompany and guide the group

Gourmet Travel's tours do not include:

1. The airfare from/to the US as well as all attached taxes and fees. The participant is responsible for organizing and arranging for the round trip from the US to the destination airport specified by Gourmet Travel. In order Gourmet Travel can pick up participants at the specified airport or arrange for their transfer from this airport to the region where the wine tour will take place, participants are kindly requested to send their flight information to Gourmet Travel by email, fax or mail and to inform Gourmet Travel by the same means of any change that might arise.
2. Medical or liability insurance. Participants are strongly advised to check with their insurance company(ies) the validity of their health and liability coverage in the European Union. Should their liability or health insurance policy be not valid, participants should take necessary actions to subscribe to supplementary coverage valid in the European Union.

Reservations/Deposits:

Reservation should be made by filling in and signing a reservation form available in the Gourmet Travel brochure or on request to our company.

A non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 is required to confirm Participant's reservation. This non-refundable deposit must be sent to Gourmet Travel with Participant's reservation coupon. If the participant chooses to send the reservation form by fax or email, the reservation will be valid upon receipt of the non-refundable deposit by Gourmet Travel.

The balance is due 21 days prior to the trip.

Reservations made less than 21 days prior to the trip are submitted to Gourmet Travel's acceptance. If accepted, the full balance will be required upon reservation.

Cancellations & Changes:

Cancellations and changes are not permitted. In all cases, the non-refundable deposit will not be refunded.

For cancellations 21 days or less before the trip, Gourmet Travel will keep all amounts paid by the Participant with no refund whatsoever. However, under some

circumstances and with no obligation, Gourmet Travel might accept a special dispensation to the present change and cancellation policy.

Documentation:

In order to comply with immigration and customs regulations, participants are required to have a valid passport with an expiration date beyond 6 months after the end of the trip.

Non-US citizens or non-EU citizens shall enquire about visa requirements in the European Union for citizens from their country as well as possible re-entry requirements in the US.

Under no circumstances, Gourmet Travel shall be responsible for participants denied boarding, entry or re-entry due to lack of proper documentation or any reasons linked to customs or immigration regulations. Participants denied boarding, entry or re-entry for any reasons whatsoever will not be entitled to a refund.

Baggage:

Baggage allowance, weight and dimensions may vary according to airlines and airfares chosen by the participant. Regarding baggage, Gourmet Travel requires participants to comply with airline regulations and international security standards.

For any information regarding baggage allowance, participants may contact the airline or travel agency that issued their ticket(s).

Gourmet Travel shall not be responsible for excess baggage, denied baggage or lost baggage. In the event of lost baggage, the participant shall contact the airline, transportation company or hotel where the baggages were lost. Baggage claims shall be submitted to the airline, transportation company or hotel. All baggage claims will be submitted by applicable regulation and limited by the airline/transportation company/hotel liability policy in this matter. Gourmet Travel may assist the participant, should the participant make a claim in Europe.

Special Need Passengers:

Hotels outside the U.S. do not comply with A.D.A. guidelines. Gourmet Travel has no control over the extent of wheelchair accessibility features. Wheelchairs and wheelchair accessible rooms therefore cannot be guaranteed. Gourmet Travel cannot guarantee the availability of wheelchairs at any airport, hotel, destination, train station or port. Special need passengers are advised to contact Gourmet Travel prior to make any plans or reservation.

Responsibility:

The liability of Gourmet Travel, their employees, agents and of the wineries is limited.

Gourmet Travel, (and its parent, subsidiaries, and affiliates) will not be responsible or liable for injury, personal injury, property damage, property and other losses, accident, delay or irregularity which may be caused either by reason or defect, through the acts or default of any company or person contracted in conveying passengers or in carrying out the arrangements of the tour, or as direct or indirect acts of God, dangers of the sea, fire, breakdown of machinery or equipment, acts of governments or other authorities de jure or de facto, wars, hostilities, civil disturbances, strike(s), riots, theft, pilferage, epidemics, quarantines, medical or customs regulations, or from any other cause beyond Gourmet Travel's control. Gourmet Travel reserves the right to decline any participant as a member of the tour, or to cancel a tour if necessary. The sole and exclusive responsibility and liability of any transportation company used in Gourmet Travel's programs shall be in accordance with and

as limited by the contract of a carriage in the participant's ticket, the applicable tariffs, and the provisions of applicable regulations and convention. Please note, hotels may require security deposits (in some cases in cash) at their discretion.

Gourmet Travel's tours involve visits at wineries and wine tastings. Participants are required to drink moderately and responsibly. Gourmet Travel reserves the right to exclude participants who shall not respect this rule in order to ensure an enjoyable trip for all participants. Gourmet Travel will not be responsible for any inconvenience, discomfort, disturbances or problems arising from participants not respecting this rule.

Gourmet Travel shall not be responsible either for inconvenience, problems, injuries or legal proceedings encountered by participants not drinking moderately and responsibly.

Gourmet Travel shall not be responsible for participants missing part or entire tour due to any reasons arising on their trip from the US to the destination airport in Europe.

Independent Contractors:

All tour services, transportation, and accommodations (the "services") provided in Gourmet Travel's tours are furnished by independent contractors over which we exercise no control. Gourmet Travel makes no guarantees or warranties, express or implied, regarding any such services. This includes, but is not limited to transfers, flights, tours, monuments, exhibitions, services and accommodations purchased or provided, as well as other features listed or not listed in this contract. Gourmet Travel reserves the right to substitute any hotel, exhibition, visits, features or services for any reason. Gourmet Travel assumes no liability for hotel overbookings resulting in inconvenience and/or substitute accommodations being provided, whether of a similar or lesser quality and location. These package inclusions/rates are based on inclusions/prices at print time and are subject to change without notice. Gourmet Travel will not be responsible or liable if any of the services, features, or facilities

described in this brochure ceases to be available or fails for any reason.
